A Ministry of Prayer

The title of our community rule book, "Search and Service," identifies my ministry of prayer. It states, "Aware that ministry will be fruitful only as it proceeds from the fullness of interior life, the sisters of the Congregation of the Humility of Mary strive to seek God solely before all else, joining their prayer to ministry."

The early years of my ministry were in the pre-Vatican II era so my prayer life was that of the community prescribed prayers. My personal prayers consisted primarily of devotions and novenas asking the Holy Spirit for inspiration and guidance for my work, community living and praying that I was doing the will of God.

In the years following Vatican II, when we became responsible for our personal prayer life, I continued to rely on prayer for myself and my ministries. The saying, "My prayer is my work," was a temptation that I found myself caught in when I realized that I was spending less time devoted to prayer and my relationship with God than I gave to my ministry. Fortunately, a life circumstance (a grace from the Holy Spirit) alerted me to what was happening. I had gone astray like a lost sheep. (Ps. 119 v. 175) Repent was the call! It was through this experience that I came to appreciate the wisdom of the statement in our

rule "...to strive to seek God solely before all else..."

Seeking to know and love God and praying has been an intense and important part of my life's journey since my childhood. In that sense, I am a natural searcher longing for ways to know and love God and developing that relationship. Now that I am no longer engaged in active ministry, one of my priorities is to deepen this search through spiritual reading, contemplative prayer, daily community prayer and the Eucharist. "Be still," the psalmist says, "and know that I am God." Being mindful of God's presence throughout the

day is one of my aspirations that blends well with my contemplative prayer practice.

The community part of my ministry of prayer includes working with our Center Liturgy Committee. We aim to observe all the elements of the liturgical cycle by celebrating the solemnities and feasts with appropriate community prayers, liturgies, music and rituals. Occasional prayer services are used to celebrate our community founders, feast days and contemporary secular events/causes. The Liturgy Committee works with the administration for a sister's funeral service and a memorial Mass for an associate. Prayer requests, however they are received, are treated with respect.

My personal prayer time begins in the chapel at night when all is quiet. It is this silence that stills my being. (Jesus often drew apart in solitude at night to pray. Mark 1:35; 6:46; Luke 5:16) This time falls into a natural flow of reading the Scriptures for the next day's liturgy, lectio divina and centering prayer. It is a time to review my day, known as the examen, continuing the novena to the Holy Spirit and special intentions including my family. Praying Compline, the night prayer of the Church, ends my prayer. This is the deepest and most healing part of my day.

After breakfast, I try to spend time sitting in my rocking chair at my bedroom window which opens to a wooded ravine, a lawn with trees and a bird feeder—a setting that in any season is an array of God's creation and an inspiration for meditation. Here I spend time doing spiritual reading, journaling and praying.

My private daily prayers always include what I call the three pillars of my prayer life: forgiveness/reconciliation, gratitude and praise to God and special prayers to the Holy Spirit.

And so We Prayed

During a sabbatical there is extended time for rest, relaxation, renewal and prayer. The glow from the 34-day experience hosted at Our Lady of the Prairie (Jan. 26 to Feb. 28) lingers on in the hearts of those sisters who attended.

We started each day with Morning Prayer and celebrated Mass weekly. Presenters wove in time for reflection, writing, meditative walks and artistic expression. We prayed our way through the sabbatical. Sr. Joan Chittister's definition of prayer describes our experience:

"Prayer is the link to a life beyond the mundane, the daily, the routine, and the immediate dimensions of life. It is the beginning of a relationship with the God who is closer to us than we are to ourselves. It is a relationship with both creation and the Creator. It grows us into the fullness of ourselves, both spiritually and psychologically."

Some of the ways in which we were encouraged to pray were:

- 1. Visio Divina—literally means "seeing the divine" through photographs and images, icons and works of art. Prayerful consideration of and interaction with an image allowed us to expand our experience of the divine. One sister saw a beautiful cotton mink that sat at attention and spoke to her of God calling and loving her.
- 2. Lectio Divina—is
 "divine reading" of
 scripture allowing a
 word or phrase to rise in
 one's consciousness. This
 holy word is savored and
 examined. In prayer each
 morning we reflected on
 the Mass readings for the
 day. Music of the same
 theme, reading of a psalm
 and silent meditation
 deepened the meaning of
 these words.
- **3.** We created Mandalas—which means "circle" in ancient Sanskrit. Mandalas offer a way to balance lines, circles and other visual elements into a unified and harmonious piece.

This form of meditative practice is kin to writing a journal. The slow, reflective process is a way to pray and communicate with God.

- 4. Learning Watercolor coupled with words of St. Francis. We learned basic watercolor technique as a way to express words of scripture, connection with nature and an image of God. This process opened new ways of seeing color, texture and spiritual meaning.
- 5. SoulCollage® for the non-artist among us, is an insightful way to use images for prayer and reflections. It is a process for tapping into our intuition by searching for images that touched us from magazine pictures. We pasted the pictures on cards and were led through guided reflection on the deeper meaning to be found there.
- 6. Contemplative Earth Walks were encouraged by most of the presenters. This simple summary gives shape to this experience: Gather yourself... Wander until you are stopped... Wait for a reply... Say thank you...
- 7. Reflection on the elements used at Mass took on new meaning as we came to know the evolutionary story of wheat, grapes, water and oil. We discovered that each of these comes

from the same root place in creation as our own bodies. No wonder Jesus chose these to celebrate his presence with us.

- 8. Christ Yesterday, Today and Forever (The Cosmic Christ) St. Paul's Letter to the Colossians (1:15-20, 21-23), selections from the Gospels, and Pope Francis' "Joy of the Gospel," painted a picture of Jesus Christ forever with us as one among us and the concerns of today. Prayer deepened as our sense of Jesus expanded.
- 9. What is the light for which you long? A final reflective process was to reflect on this question. A follow up reflection was "This is important for me because..." repeated until we ran out of things to say. Prayer in this context brought us to root beliefs, a deepened sense of God's love, and a way to see into the future.

Prayer melded our sabbatical experience into a reflective, healing experience. Our Lady of the Prairie Retreat again proved to be the perfect place to ponder the Holy—to trust God's revelation and grace.
