

Listening with an Open Heart

The Congregation of the Humility of Mary (CHM) embraced a theme for their community for the year 2018 of "listening with an open heart." One might reflect on the history of the sisters' ministries and think, this isn't new, but the way it has always been. The CHM mission statement reads, "Like our founders, we strive to be attentive to the call of the spirit in the signs of our times, especially the needs of the poor and the powerless."

Often, in this publication we have focused on CHM sponsored ministries – Humility of Mary Housing and Shelter projects and Our Lady of the Prairie Retreat: wonderful works with positive effects in the Quad City community. We have also focused on individual sisters who minister in Colorado, Montana, Mississippi, Iowa, Illinois and

Mexico. Here sisters humbly work and minister to their communities in a variety of ways.

But these physical works of the gospel do not complete the picture. Currently as a community, CHMs practice solidarity through prayer, hospitality and financial support.

The financial support comes through the Humility of Mary People's Investment Fund which provides funding for emergency loans or grants to individuals and to groups seeking to alleviate poverty and injustice. The CHM Resource Stewardship Advisory Committee reviews large requests and determines where funds will be allocated. Some have included:

•Central Community Circle Food Pantry – providing food for the hungry in Davenport, Iowa

- •Homeless Veteran's Stand Down of Des Moines – providing supplies and services to homeless veterans
- •Diversity Service Center of Iowa providing education, information and social services to people from all over the world who live in Muscatine and surrounding areas.
- •Bread for the World ending hunger
- •Sister Water Project bringing safe water to villages in Tanzania and Honduras
- •Mexican American Catholic College dealing with religious life, specifically the language and cultural component
- Pace e Bene building a culture of peace


I hear the frightened voices of immigrants and refugees with nowhere to turn and few to give them counsel. I hear the desperation of families shackled to systems hopelessly broken.

Being a Healing Presence in our Broken World

Each of us, whether directly or not, was affected by yet another school shooting in Parkland, FL, on Ash Wednesday. Different this time is the response to the shooting, particularly from the youth in Florida and around the country. Grief, fear and anger have been positive motivators as youth use their voices in rallies and protests to convey the need for legislation to help bring an end to gun violence. I have been inspired by these youth who in response to this traumatic event are taking action for the benefit of all. It is not difficult to see God at work in the midst of such violence and loss.

What does all of this tell us in the context of the church document "Young People, the Faith and Vocational Discernment"? Two quotes struck me as especially pertinent. The document quotes Pope Francis in Laudato Sí: "Human beings, while capable of the worst, are also capable of rising above themselves, choosing again what is good, and making a new start..." The document also says, "It is important that young people-often withdrawn into a stereotype of passivity and inexperience-propose and practice alternatives which show how the world or the Church could be..."

Our personal and communal experiences play a major part in discerning how God is calling us to be our best selves. We experience our joys and sorrows in the context of a member of a family, a member of

the Catholic Church, and a member of our country and global community. Sifting through those joys and sorrows, and all of our other feelings, we ask, "Where is God in all of this? How is God asking me to use these experiences, along with my gifts and talents, to make the world a better place?"

Most of the time, this is a

long, gradual process, a path of exploration that requires patience. Other times, something happens that causes a sudden major shift and sets us on a path we never would have imagined. Sometimes it is a path we would have never chosen in the first place, especially if it involves tragedy and grief. But when we come together behind a common goal and vision, it is a powerful force. We know that we are not alone, and together we can accomplish so much more than any individual.

These recent events are a reminder that youth have their own wisdom and a voice that needs to be heard. I am reminded of Jeremiah (Jer 1:5-9) who told God that he was too young to speak as a prophet. God assured Jeremiah that he indeed was called and that God would be with him. I see these youth responding to the Florida school shooting as

prophetic, by giving voice to their needs and calling for change that has so far not been accomplished. They are a voice saying "never again." Certainly this is not the world God imagines for us, whether we are a student, teacher, parent, or a person who is so troubled inside that we resort to violence.

I recently attended a session of the ForMission program, which is designed by the Religious Formation Conference for religious in formation ministry (journeying with those in the process of entering religious life). One of the speakers, Sr. Linda Gibler, spoke about the universe story and evolution in a religious context. Those of us present tended to be the younger members of our religious congregations. We were delighted when Sr. Linda described how juvenile chimpanzees are the ones who first came down from the trees to be adventurous and explore new paths.

It is tragic that it takes repeated events like school shootings to move us to action. Yet I am proud and hopeful to see the way in which youth have responded. Whether they are mindful of it or not, they are surely following God's call. While their path changed in an instant, they have a long road of healing ahead of them. Let each of us discern how we can be a healing presence in our broken world.
