Sisters Keep on Keepin' On

Being an apostolic community with the freedom to choose a career (self-determination), sisters of the Congregation of the Humility of Mary (CHM) enter the workforce just like many women in modern history with occupations that include teachers, nurses, lawyers, social workers and medical doctors. In each case, CHMs incorporate the congregation's mission into their work. Does the dedication to the mission change when a sister retires?

According to 86-year-old Sr. Helen Strohman, God puts you where you need to be at each phase of your life. Sr. Helen was a teacher who spent more than 50 years in the classroom. She spent time teaching in Minnesota and Iowa; however, the majority of her career was in Mississippi. After leaving the traditional classroom,

she found a second career helping county jail inmates prepare to take the General Education Diploma (GED). "I really felt like I was helping people," Sr. Helen commented. "I had a person stop me on the street and ask, 'aren't you Sr. Helen?' I told him I was and he told me that I taught him in jail. I asked if he got his GED and he said yes." Sr. Helen was pleased when he also told her that he now has a job and was turning his life around.

Following her work with jail inmates, Sr. Helen was asked to start an English as a Second Language (ESL) class at Sacred Heart Church and to assist the Sisters of Notre Dame with an ESL program at their education center in Canton, Mississippi.

She helps take care of two retired priests who are biological brothers. In addition to this, she helps part

time with a self-storage business and finds that once customers discover she is a woman religious, they often feel called to share their problems with her because she is a good listener. "The work that I have done hasn't always been easy, but I've enjoyed it," she says.

Sr. Sue Sellers doesn't see herself as retired. "I'm a doer," she said as she described all of her current endeavors. She started her career as an elementary teacher in Iowa, Montana and Colorado before accepting positions at Ottumwa Heights and then Marycrest.

Sr. Sue spent a couple years as director of Humility of Mary Center in Davenport before returning permanently to the Des Moines area, which is her hometown, to work at Bishop Drumm Retirement Center (BDRC) in Johnston, IA. Her ministries allowed her to work with people at various stages of life. "I enjoy all ages," she said.

"I didn't think about retiring until I was faced with a cancer diagnosis six years ago," said Sue. Her cancer treatment was successful and she retired as CHM coordinator at BDRC, leaving her time to focus on other activities.

Sr. Sue continues to volunteer at BDRC in the sisters' wing and once a month she is on-call for emergencies. She attends daily Mass and maintains close relationships with the sisters. She is a long-time member of the Johnston Lion's Club and is active in the club's farmers' market, Kidsight program, and book sale. "I don't know how I had time to work," she reflected.

Answering the call to serve where needed has been significant in Sr. Kathleen Henneberry's ministries throughout her career and retirement. She was an elementary school teacher before choosing pastoral and parish ministry positions in Iowa and Minnesota. She served as CHM coordinator at BDRC. She relished a sabbatical before she became an assistant at Our Lady of the Prairie Retreat.

In retirement, Sr. Kathleen serves as one of the sacristans at Humility of Mary Center in Davenport. On her assigned days, she prepares the Magnificat Chapel for Mass, including care of the vestments and purificators and assisting with seasonal liturgical decor. "I take the ministry of prayer seriously," notes Sr. Kathleen. She pays close attention to the prayer board outside of the Magnificat Chapel and makes time everyday to reflect on these requests.

Action for the Common Good, a citizens' group with core values of social justice, empowerment, sustainability and community. Sr. Kathleen participates in the environmental forum for this group. "I love being outdoors and hearing the sounds of the birds, and the wind lifts my spirits," she said. "It's a way that I touch base with Jesus."

Relationships are important to Sr. Kathleen. "I want to be there for my family, friends, sisters and employees at Humility of Mary Center. I'm just as busy as I always have been. I enjoy the freedom of being able to choose how to spend my time based on my values," she stated.

Sr. Catherine Talarico stressed that retired people need to stay engaged with activities. "Being part of something and keeping connections is important to staying happy and healthy," she said. Sr. Catherine retired in 2015 after a fulfilling and varied career. She started as a junior high teacher and moved on to positions in pastoral ministry, housing and mental health programs in the Des Moines area.

Like most sisters, she was involved in volunteer work before retirement. She became involved in an art program at the Iowa Correctional Institution for Women in Mitchellville with Sr. Donna Schmitt in the 1980s. continues to volunteer there once a week. "I enjoy being with the women and getting to know them. The activities we do bring out their creativity—even for those who think they aren't creative." According to Sr. Catherine, the program includes an opportunity for reflection.

Her ministry working with the homeless also connected her with the Des Moines Veterans Stand Down. This three-day event connects veterans and non-veterans experiencing homelessness or near homelessness with services, assistance and necessities like clothing. Sr. Catherine is responsible for recruiting and coordinating volunteers for haircuts and massages for attendees who would like these services. Throughout the year she helps raise money for this program.

In addition to these volunteer roles, having coffee with others and taking care of her big garden provide opportunities for spiritual therapy. "As part of my prayer time, I reflect on our CHM charism, mission and vision statements to remind me of what is important in my life," she noted. Sr. Catherine's advice to anyone entering retirement is to take a few months before making commitments. "Wait and see what pulls at you."


