# CHMs commit to sustainable future

Laudato Si' is an encyclical of Pope Francis published in May 2015. It focuses on care for the natural environment and all people, as well as broader questions of the relationship among God, humans and the earth. The encyclical's subtitle, "Care for Our Common Home," reinforces these key themes. In November 2022, Congregation of the Humility of Mary made a formal commitment to its Laudato Si' Action Plan. Below are the seven goals outlined in Pope Francis' Laudato Si' encyclical and the action steps identified by CHM. Read more about CHM's Laudato Si' journey on page 8.

## Response to the Cry of the Earth

Action: Engage professionals to advise ways to mitigate erosion and investigate the possibility of planting grasses along the ravine on the HMC property to create beauty.

2

## Response to the Cry of the Poor

Action: Given serious concerns about increased suicide rates in children, look at ways for the community to engage with young people, possibly through Project Renewal and the Lincoln Center in Davenport.

## Ecological Economics

Action: Determine the decrease in electricity use and share this information with the community since the installation of more solar panels at OLPR, assessing and raising awareness about energy conservation.

## Adoption of Sustainable Lifestyles

Action: In coordination with congregational and HMC staff, determine at least two ways to increase sustainability at HMC. A recommended focus is on increasing recycling efforts and to continue exploring the addition of solar panels in the area of HMC.

5

## Ecological Education

Action: Education is included in the action steps of goals 2 and 4. Both the CHM congregation and staff will be involved in educational efforts.

6

## Ecological Spirituality

Action: Create community prayer services to celebrate the spring equinox and winter solstice, with a land acknowledgment statement.

7

## Community Resilience and Empowerment

Action: Research ways to collaborate with established groups doing outreach to the broader community to increase voter registration and participation in the 2024 elections.

### Sr. Mary Kayleen Heffron

Sr. Mary Kayleen Heffron, CHM, died March 6, 2023. She was born April 4, 1931, in Georgetown, Iowa, to Michael and Agnes (Murphy) Heffron. She entered the Congregation of the Humility of Mary in 1959 and professed vows in 1962.

Sr. Kayleen was an accomplished nurse, having completed her RN degree from the St. Joseph School of Nursing in Ottumwa, Iowa, her Associate's degree from Ottumwa Heights College in Ottumwa and her BSN in nursing from St. Ambrose College in Davenport, Iowa. Sister also took graduate courses at the University of Iowa.

Once her RN was completed, Sr. Kayleen worked as a nurse in the Monroe County Hospital in Albia, Iowa. She served at St. Joseph Hospital in Ottumwa for 23 years as a nurse.



After the closure of the St. Joseph Health and Rehabilitation Center, she worked as an RN in the Skilled Nursing Facility and Physical Rehab Unit at the Ottumwa Regional Health Center until her retirement.

### Sr. Helen Strohmman



Sr. Helen Strohmman, CHM, died on April 7, 2023. She was born December 13, 1932, in Keswick, Iowa, to Leo and Mary Agnes (Dunn) Strohmman. She entered the Congregation of the Humility of Mary in 1952 and professed final vows in 1957.

Sr. Helen studied education at Ottumwa Heights College in Ottumwa, and Marycrest College in Davenport. She began her teaching career at St. Anthony School in Des

Moines. She served as a teacher, minister and educational program director at over 20 locations in Iowa, Minnesota, Mississippi and Illinois.

Outside the role of traditional teacher, she also served programs dedicated to bringing educational opportunities to those who otherwise lacked them, including providing education for county jail inmates, helping them to earn their GEDs. She also served as a pastoral minister and caregiver in Iowa and Illinois and finally as the director of the Sacred Heart Hispanic Outreach in Canton, Mississippi.

# Seeking ways to reduce the world's carbon footprint

## *CHMs ready to lead the discussion*

Sr. Lynn Mousel has evolved from her first reaction to the unveiling of Pope Francis' 2015 *Laudato Si'* encyclical. Reflecting on that time, she says, "I guess if I am really honest, I knew it was important but wasn't sure how to get started. With so many other things drawing my attention, it didn't reach the level of priority that it could have."

Pope Francis' 2015 encyclical imploring all people to care for earth and each other begins with the words "*Laudato Si', mi' Signore*" — "Praise be to you, my Lord." With this, the concept of inserting faith into the discussion of the environmental crisis by seeking social and economic solutions that safeguard human beings, especially poor and marginalized people, began in earnest.

Sr. Lynn's initial reaction to taking a more active approach to global warming is not uncommon. A 2022 survey conducted by the Yale Program on Climate Change Communication, revealed that 68 percent of those living in the United States report being "very worried" or "somewhat worried" about climate change; however, 64 percent of those in the U.S. also say they "rarely" or "never" discuss global warming. When it comes to actually doing something, only seven percent "are currently" participating in an organized group for climate action, with nine percent indicating they

"definitely would" participate and 25 percent indicating they "probably would."

Following the call from the Vatican for religious entities, including parishes, schools and congregations, to form a seven-year plan toward sustainability, CHM began an evaluation in November 2021 of actions already being taken by the congregation. Sr. Lynn and Sr. Kathleen Henneberry agreed to be part of a Leadership Conference of Women Religious (LCWR) email communication group. With the support of LCWR and CHM leadership, Sr. Lynn was ready to lead this effort. "Once we started communicating, I really got on board," she says. A *Laudato Si'* committee was formed and new projects were identified. In November 2022, a prayer service was held to make a formal commitment to CHM's *Laudato Si'* Action Plan which was then submitted to the Global Action Platform.

"I think that CHM really had a bit of a head start because care of earth has been a part of our charism and mission statement for a long time," Sr. Lynn states. Nevertheless, part of the challenge with the formation of any new plan, Sr. Lynn says, is not just creating it, but communicating and sustaining the action. CHM plans to keep the enthusiasm alive by using multiple communication conduits.

Earlier this year, the congregation introduced a monthly newsletter, "*Down to Humus*," dedicated to care for our common home. Readers can submit ideas, earth-friendly links and recipes. The newsletter is shared in the monthly CHM Spirit E-newsletter that is available on the CHM Facebook page and through email subscription.

In March, in conjunction with Catholic Sisters Week, a *Laudato Si'* celebration was held for CHMs, associates and staff. At the event, attendees had the opportunity to share ideas and have been challenged to continue the conversation by submitting things that they do and suggestions for sustainable actions the community could do. To support this, a display has been set up at Humility of Mary Center with information about the CHM Action Plan and a place to share tips, ideas and suggestions, including details about a local non-profit that recycles bathroom, kitchen and office items not accepted by local recycling centers.

CHM employee Teri Reyhons was impacted by the information presented at the celebration and on the display. "I worry for our generations to come," she says. "I know I will be talking with my family on this issue more and more and we will do our part to reduce our carbon footprint."



# Footprint

CHM Laudato Si' committee member Sr. Lillian Stevens likes the increased awareness that the recent activities have produced. The concepts that we are all in this together and that small actions can add up to big actions if we get enough people to participate are motivational. She acknowledges that discussions about climate change can be difficult because we are reluctant to change our ways. "Denial and avoidance are too common; we have to start encouraging each other," she implores.

Sr. Kathleen agrees that we are not talking about climate change enough and she is pleased to see discussions continuing beyond the November prayer service and March celebration. "We need to talk about climate change on a regular basis and address the ways that the earth has been plundered," she says. "We are so interconnected—we just are not going to survive without plants, animals and unpolluted air."

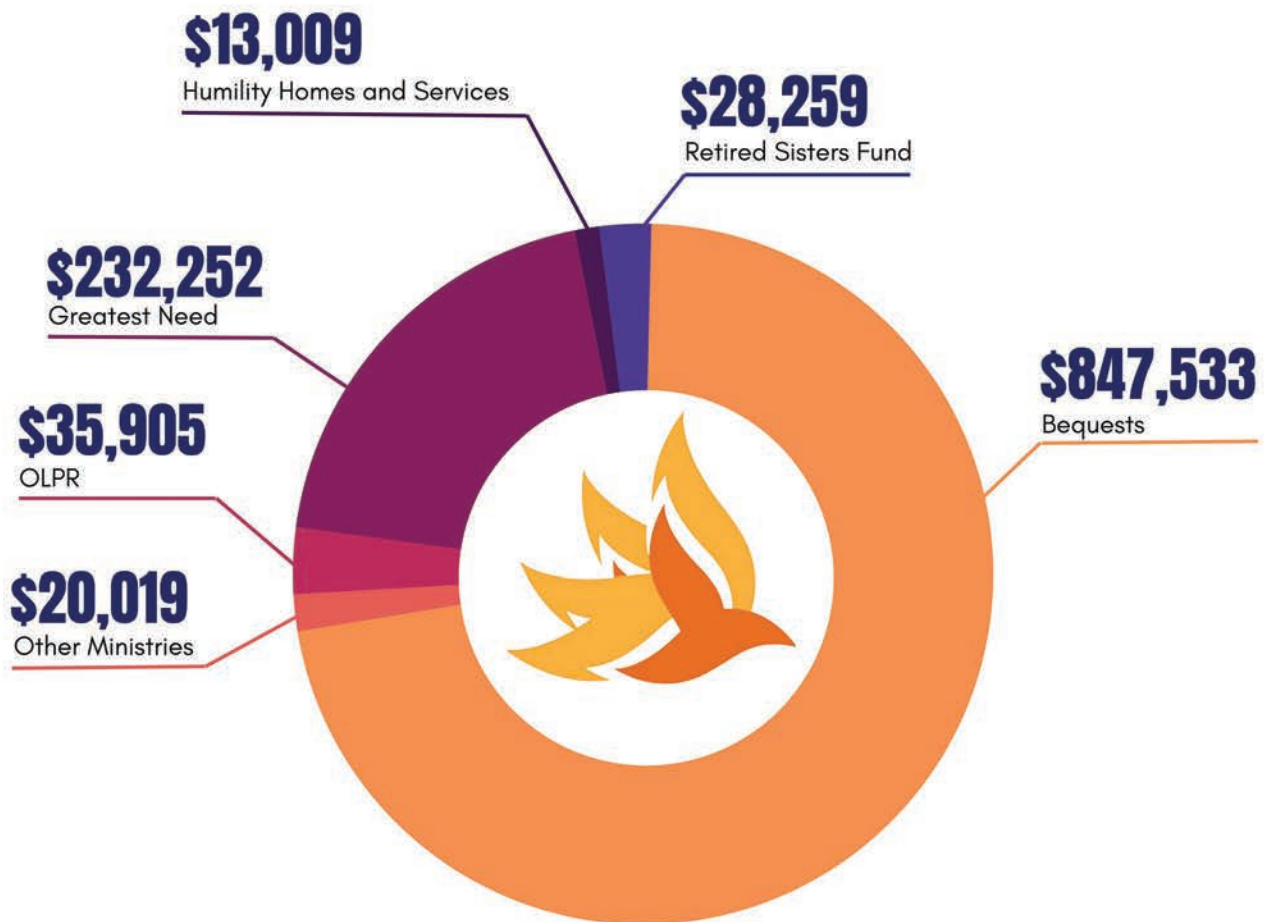
